

Clinical academic pay scales (Wales) 2024/25

1. Summary of changes

1.1 Consultants

The pay scale for medical and dental consultants has been increased by 6% to basic pay with effect from **1 April 2024.**

This is *in addition* to the reform of the pay scale for medical and dental consultants effective from 1 January 2024 as notified in UCEA <u>Update 24:030</u>.

The National Clinical Impact awards remain unchanged from last year.

1.2 Doctors and dentists in training

The pay scales for doctors and dentists in training have been increased by 6% to basic pay plus an additional £1,000 consolidated payment with effect from **1 April 2024**.
